Case Study: North York General Hospital's (NYGH) Digital Oncology Patient Education Platform

Effective in-person chairside education in bustling oncology clinics was quickly becoming an outdated model even before COVID forced us into a more virtual space in 2019. Lack of staffing resources, privacy, excess noise, etc., were not conducive to either teaching or learning.

Enter a team of pharmacists, nurses, oncologists, and advisors from NYGH who, together with the support of Apobiologix and IMD Health, created a series of animated educational videos for patients to watch on their own time or during chemotherapy sessions. Easy to understand, professional, and fully vetted, these videos were a game-changer in the clinic.

In addition to **significantly reducing consultation time for pharmacists**, the pilot study showed¹:

- **28%** of patients watched the videos during chemotherapy
- **65%** of patients e-mailed the videos to themselves and watched them at home
- **13%** emailed the videos to another person

100% satisfaction rate from patients¹

Consistent positive feedback from patients regarding the IMD Health platform, has propelled NYGH to enhance dissemination, incorporate Cancer Care Ontario (CCO) materials, and to continue to build their video library.

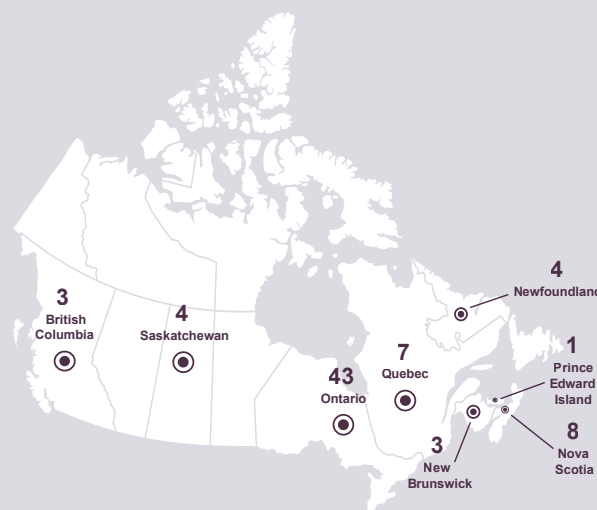

Year 1 Summary



- ABC launched in fall 2021, receiving over 100 inquiries in 4 months
- Due to high demand, a second cohort was added in Jan 2022
- 10 presenters, 20 panelists from leading centres across Canada
- ~75 participants to date (across 2 cohorts), from the majority of provinces across Canada
- 93% weekly average attendance rate
- Materials from the program made available after completion

* Based on an online survey of 100 randomly selected stakeholders (56 oncologists and other physicians treating cancer, 20 oncology DANs, 14 oncology pharmacists and 10 oncology nurses) from across Canada to measure their attitudes and perceptions of oncology PSPs based on 3 key metrics: 1. Overall unaided mentions as having one of the 3 best oncology PSPs in Canada; 2. Satisfaction ratings of each PSP with respect to 6 key attributes specifically developed to evaluate oncology PSPs (namely: access to needed cancer therapies, ease of enrolling patients, support for HCPs and DANs, reliable communications with the PSP, patient education and support and other services that are drug specific); and 3. overall satisfaction with each PSP. ANSWERS ranked among the top 3 out of 22 oncology PSPs.
